- Program development and funding plan for EV charging infrastructure
- Research a strategy, revenue forecast, and opportunities for resilience infrastructure bonds, mitigation banks, and resilience funds
- Develop a financing strategy for a regional climate action plan

Project Overview

Throwe Environmental (TE) is working with the Resilience Authority of Annapolis and Anne Arundel County to help the Authority identify and implement short-term projects that will establish a record of success and serve as the Authority's programmatic foundation moving forward. TE will use its collective expertise to assist the Authority in implementing resilience projects, primarily by identifying sustainable sources of revenue and financing mechanisms to support priority projects and programs.

Core Project Outcomes

By the end of this project, the Authority will have a completed strategic plan, as well as an actionable roadmap for implementation. The Authority will also have an enhanced ability to pursue funding and opportunities for regional coordination. With these competencies, the Authority will be the driving force for climate resilience in Anne Arundel County and the City of Annapolis.
