Project Overview

Throwe Environmental developed a multi-faceted Climate Leadership Exchange series to guide the <u>Town of Wareham</u> in the exploration of sustainable redevelopment options to revitalize downtown Wareham Village. Throwe hosted a <u>four-part webinar series</u> focused on green infrastructure, climate resilience, waterfront redevelopment, and smart growth. Coinciding with the webinars, Throwe launched <u>"The Leadership</u> <u>Exchange Podcast"</u> to share interviews with leaders from communities across the US that served as case studies for each of the event topics.

Summary of Findings & Key Recommendations

Upon conclusion of the project, Throwe provided Wareham with a <u>suite of</u> <u>recommendations</u> to advance sustainable redevelopment efforts. These recommendations included (1) embedding resilience within the Town's leadership structure and existing institutions, (2) developing a holistic approach to incorporating green infrastructure in all projects, and (3) reviewing existing zoning to incorporate smart growth principles.
