GLO INITIATIVE CAN SUPPORT DEVELOPMENT OF:

- **Lead Service Line (LSL) Inventories** that meet 2021 Lead and Copper Rule Revisions requirements deadline
- **Community Engagement Plans** that invite community-wide input, provide educational resources, and meaningfully engage affected residents and community members while identifying and replacing LSLs
- **LSL Replacement Plans** to provide each municipality a roadmap for 100% identification and full replacement of all LSLs, including public and private portions
- **State Revolving Fund Applications** to help communities fund their service line replacement.

Project Overview

The GLO Initiative is an Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) administered and Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) funded effort to accelerate the removal of LSLs, with a focus on underserved and disadvantaged communities. The GLO Initiative will connect approximately 200 communities with technical assistance over the next two years (2024-2025). [Visit the GLO Initiative webpage for more information.](#)
